

# Our History

In the beginning there were six small clubs in Hamilton all running basic programmes using fundamental movement. With limited resources and no purpose built facility.

In 1992, Old Tech (blue and white) and Old Boys (red and white) came together to form Hamilton City Gymnastics. St Andrews (blue) joined 5 years later in 1997. When Rukuhia (black, purple, yellow) went into recess in 1999 their gymnasts joined Hamilton City Gymnastics.

# New Building

Hamilton City Gymnastics originally operated out of Kahikatea drive, when the lease ran out there was a move to Norris Ave (now RML). While waiting for the new building to be built HCG leased a building which is now the skate park across from the current location in Sunshine Ave.

From rented premises to a building of our own gave us a sense of pride and cemented our place in the community and as a force in the gymnastics world. The shift also meant not having to put equipment in and out, less wear and tear on equipment and the ability to run programmes every day, all day.

Building of the Mainstreet Place site started in September 2001.  
The building was completed by April 2002  
The opening ceremony was held on May 2003  
Officially opened on the 17th of May 2003 by
