



The Beginnings

- 1952 - Gymnastics growing in popularity in community clubs and YMCA'S
- 1953 - Members of the Auckland Association visit Hamilton and discuss the possibility of forming a New Zealand Gymnastics Association .
- 1954 - Hamilton YMCA group visits Australia in August. Meeting in Hamilton to consider forming a New Zealand Association. Waikato Gymnastics Association formed.
- 1957 - Brownlie, Cole and Sandos form Hamilton Old Boys Club. Old Tech Gym Club formed around this time as well.
- 1958 - Incentive awards scheme introduced.
- 1959 - First Schools competition held in Auckland.
- 1992 - Old Boys and Old Tech joined to form Hamilton City Gymnastics, located at Kahikatea Drive.
- 1997 - Hamilton City merged with St Andrews gym club moving to a new premises in Norris Ave.
- 2002 - Hamilton City Gym leased a facility which is now the skate park in Sunshine Ave while waiting for our current building to be constructed.
- 17th May 2003 - Hamilton City Gymnastics was officially opened in Sunshine Ave.
